ORDINANCE NO. 2420

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 4-6 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE REGULATING THE PRESENCE OF MINORS IN PREMISES LICENSED FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4-6 of the Lexington City Code is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

Sec. 4-6. – Presence of underage persons where alcoholic beverages are consumed on the premises.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person or persons who own or manage any premises licensed for sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises, to allow any person under the age of 21 years to be or remain within the licensed premises after 9:00 P.M. on any date, unless said underage person is accompanied by their parent or legal guardian.
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 21 years to be within the licensed premises of a business establishment licensed for sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises, after 9:00 P.M. on any date, unless said persons are accompanied by their parent or legal guardian.
- (c) The provisions of this Section shall not apply to employees of the licensed premises who are legally entitled to serve or dispense alcoholic beverages. The provisions of this section shall not apply to licensed premises whose primary business is providing food, lodging, reception or meeting hall, or a bowling alley.
- (d) The owner or manager of the licensed premises shall post a notice that persons under the age of 21 are not allowed after 9:00 p.m.
- **Section 2.** That all ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- **Section 3.** That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
