A Planning Session of the Lexington City Council was held Saturday, January 16, 2010, at the Lexington Municipal Building, located at 406 East 7th Street, Lexington, Nebraska at 8:00 a.m. Members of the Council present were John Fagot, Steve Tomasek, John Salem, Joni Bennett, and Linda Miller. City Officials present were City Manager Joe Peplitsch, Assistant City Manager Dennis Burnside, City Attorney Will Weinhold and Deputy City Clerk Pamela Berke.

ROUNDTABLE: Burnside noted that the Downtown Revitalization Study group will be conducting consultant selection in the coming week.

Fagot reported that the Department of Labor will be conducting an open house on January 28th to discuss an assistance program targeting Tenneco employees and area employers.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business to come before Council, Mayor Fagot declared the meeting adjourned.
