A Regular Meeting of the Lexington City Council was held Tuesday, July 24, 2018, at the Lexington City Hall, 406 E. 7th Street, Lexington, Nebraska at 5:30 p.m. Members of the Council present were John Fagot, John Salem, Dora Vivas, Steve Smith and Jeremy Roberts. City Officials present were City Manager Joe Pepplitsch, Assistant City Manager Dennis Burnside, Finance Director Barb Hodges, City Attorney Brian Copley, and City Clerk Pamela Baruth. ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION: Pepplitsch gave an update on several current projects and reminded Council and Staff of the Work Session scheduled for Saturday, August 4, 2018, at 8:00 a.m. Burnside noted that he and other community members will be meeting with a representative of the Census Bureau to begin preliminary work on Census 2020.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business to come before the Council, Fagot declared the meeting adjourned.
