A Regular Meeting of the Lexington City Council was held Tuesday, September 24, 2019, at the Lexington City Hall, 406 E. 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Lexington, Nebraska at 5:30 p.m. Members of the Council present were John Fagot, John Salem, Dora Vivas, Steve Smith and Jeremy Roberts. City Officials present were City Manager Joe Pepplitsch, Assistant City Manager Dennis Burnside, Finance Director Barb Hodges, and City Clerk Pamela Baruth. The press was represented by Clipper-Herald and Tri-City Trib.

**ORDINANCE:** Ordinance No. 2420 entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 4-6 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE REGULATING THE PRESENCE OF MINORS IN PREMISES LICENSED FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM" was presented. Following discussion, Staff was instructed to prepare an ordinance repealing Section 4-6 of the city code for future consideration.

**ORDINANCE:** Ordinance No. 2421 entitled AN ORDINANCE TO DEDICATE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM" was presented. Pepplitsch explained that a portion of Frontier Street to be deemed as Right-of-Way was inadvertently overlooked during the original dedication of the street. Following discussion, moved by Salem, seconded by Smith, to suspend the rules regarding the reading of an ordinance on three separate occasions. Roll call. Voting "aye" were Vivas, Roberts, Smith, Salem, Fagot. Motion carried.

Ordinance No. 2421 was presented on final reading. Move by Smith, seconded by Salem, to approve Ordinance No. 2421 on final reading. Roll call. Voting "aye" were Vivas, Roberts, Salem, Smith, Fagot. Motion carried.

**WORK SESSION:** Moved by Salem, seconded by Vivas, to schedule a Council work session on Saturday, November 2, 2019, at 8:00 a.m. Roll call. Voting "aye" were Smith, Roberts, Vivas, Salem, Fagot. Motion carried.

**ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION:** There were no items to discuss.

**ADJOURNMENT:** There being no further business to come before the Council, Fagot declared the meeting adjourned.
