A Regular Meeting of the Lexington City Council was held Tuesday, May 10, 2022, at Lexington, Nebraska at 5:30 p.m. Members of the Council present were John Fagot, John Salem, Steve Smith, and Jeremy Roberts. Dora Vivas was excused. City Officials present were City Manager Joe Pepplitsch, Assistant City Manager Dennis Burnside, and City Attorney Brian Copley. The press was represented by the Clipper-Herald.

RESOLUTION NO 2022 - 10

Whereas, Nebraska Revised Statutes Section 60-680 authorizes the City of Lexington to designate the location of stop signs;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

That the Lexington City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to install stop signs at the following locations:

- 1. Intersection of the west exit of an access drive from Kirkpatrick Memorial Park to Monroe Street, to stop west bound traffic on the access drive from Kirkpatrick Memorial Park entering Monroe Street.
- 2. Intersection of the south exit of an access drive from Kirkpatrick Memorial Park to 7th Street, to stop south bound traffic on the access drive from Kirkpatrick Memorial Park entering 7th street.
