A Regular Meeting of the Lexington City Council was held Tuesday, June 13, 2023, at Lexington, Nebraska at 5:30 p.m. Members of the Council present were John Fagot, John Salem, Dora Vivas, Steve Smith, and Jeremy Roberts. CHANGE ORDER: Pepplitsch reviewed Change Order #2 from Walters-Morgan Construction for the 2021 Wastewater Facility Improvements project for an increase of \$18,250.00. He noted this was for potable water and infrastructure required for testing that was not included in the original contract. Following discussion, moved by Smith, seconded by Roberts, to approve Change Order #2 as presented. Roll call. Voting "aye" were Vivas, Salem, Roberts, Smith, Fagot. Motion carried.

PAY REQUEST: Pepplitsch reviewed Pay Request #1 in the amount of \$69,087.60 from Lacy Construction for the 2020 Wastewater Equipment Procurement – Bid D project. Following a project update, moved by Salem, seconded by Vivas, to approve Pay Request #1 as presented. Roll call. Voting "aye" were Smith, Roberts, Vivas, Salem, Fagot. Motion carried.

PROJECT CLOSEOUT: Pepplitsch reviewed project close documents for the Revere Circle and Prescott Circle project. Pay Request #3-Final in the amount of \$10,040.79 and the Certificate of Substantial Completion were considered. Following an update of the project, moved by Smith, seconded by Roberts, to approve close out documents for the Revere Circle and Prescott Circle project as presented. Roll call. Voting "aye" were Vivas, Salem, Roberts, Smith, Fagot. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION: Resolution No. 2023-11 was presented for Council consideration. Following discussion, moved by Vivas, seconded by Salem, to approve Resolution No. 2023-11 as presented. Roll call. Voting "aye" were Smith, Roberts, Salem, Vivas, Fagot. Motion carried.
