ORDINANCE RECORD

CITY HALL LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA

The Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, met in regular special session in the City Hall at 8 o'clock P. M., on July 10th 1945 Mayor Cook presided and W.R. Egenberger City Clerk recorded the proceedings of this meeting.

The Mayor instructed the Clerk to call the roll. The Clerk called the roll and the following Councilmen were present: Reynolds, Morganson, Seaman, Hebrew, Smith, and Reutlinger.

Absent: None.

Whereupon the Mayor announced that the introduction of ordinances was now in order, and the matter now coming before the Mayor and Council was the passage and approval of Ordinance No. 401 of the City of Lexington, Nebraska.

This ordinance was introduced by Councilman Smith and is in words and figures as follows, to wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 401 Appropriation Bill

An Ordinance appropriating money of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska for the purpose of paying liabilities, current expenses and for necessary improvements for the fiscal year, 1945. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of money to be raised by general levy of taxes upon all property within the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and of money now on hand and money to be received from collectuin of water rent, for the purpose of paying present liabilities, current expenses and for necessary improvements and expenses of said City for the fiscal year 1945, the following sums of money, to-wit:

General Fund -----	\$ 18,000.00
Aviation Field Maintenance -----	2,400.00
Maint. & Improvement & Extension of Water Works ----	18,000.00
Maintenance of Fire Department -----	2,500.00
Fire Department Equipment -----	2,500.00
Sewer Maintenance -----	3,000.00
Amusements -----	1,800.00
Electric Lights & Power -----	9,000.00
City Park Fund -----	4,000.00
City Library Fund -----	5,000.00
Cemetery Fund -----	4,000.00
Interest & Sinking Fund on Water Refunding Bonds ---	2,500.00
Int. & Sinking Fund on Dist. Paving & Refunding Bonds	22,000.00
Int. & Sinking Fund on Aviation Field Bonds -----	2,500.00
Road Fund -----	9,000.00
Total -----	106,200.00
