## CITY HALL LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA

The Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, met in regular special session in the City Hall at 8:00 o'clock P.M., on August 6, 1946, Mayor W.A. Stewart, Jr. presided and City Clerk A.R. Kirkpatrick, recorded the proceedings of this meeting.

The Mayor instructed the Clerk to call the roll. The Clerk called the roll and the following Councilmen were present: W.R. Smith, M. Morganson, W.R. Hemmelstrand, M.E. Hebrew, and R.R. Reutlinger.

Absent: Paul McGuire.

Whereupon the Mayor announced that the introduction of ordinances was now in order, and the matter now coming before the Mayor and Council was the passage and approval of Ordinance No. 425 of the City of Lexington, Nebraska.

This ordinance was introduced by Councilman Hebrew and is in words and figures as follows, to wit:

### ORDINANCE NO. 425,

An ordinance designating the street between Tracts "I" and "H" of Abel's First Addition, as North Jackson Street, and to vacate a portion of said street.

Be It Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska:

Section 1: That the street as surveyed, platted and recorded, running north and south, between Tracts "I" and "H" of Abel's First Addition to the City of Lexington, Nebraska, shall be designated as a part of North Jackson Street in said city.

Section 2: That such portion of North Jackson Street, commencing at a point three hundred forty (340) feet North of the south section line of Section Thirty-Two (32) in Township Ten (10) North, Range Twenty-One (21) West of the 6th P.M. in Dawson County, Nebraska, which section line is also the center line of East Thirteenth Street, and said place of beginning being also the south line of Lots One (1) and Thirty-one (31) of Woodlawn Addition, thence north a distance of eight hundred twenty (820) feet to the north line of Lots Sixteen (16) and Seventeen (17) of said Woodlawn Addition to said City of Lexington, Nebraska, as surveyed, platted, and recorded, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 3: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
