Lexington , Nebraska.
February 24, 1948.

The Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington Dawson County, Nebraska, met in regular (special) (adjourned) session in the City Hall at 8 o'clock P. M. Mayor Stewart presided. City Clerk Kirkpatrick recorded the proceedings of this meeting.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

Whereupon the Mayor announced that the introduction of ordinances was now in order.

ORDINANCE NO. 475

Introduction of Ordinance No. 475 of the City of Lexington , Nebraska.

And the matter now coming before the Mayor and Council was the passage and approval of Ordinance No. 475 of the City of Lexington , Nebraska. This ordinance was introduced by Councilman Reutlinger , and is in words and figures as follows, to-wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 475

An ordinance to combine and merge the office of City Clerk and the office of City Treasurer and to provide for the salary of the officer holding the merged and combined offices of City Clerk and City Treasurer.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. That from and after May 1, 1948, the office of City Clerk and the office of City Treasurer in the City of Lexington, Nebraska, shall be merged and combined into one office, and such office shall be held by the duly elected or appointed Clerk of said City.

Section 2. That the salary of the officer holding the merged or combined office of City Clerk and City Treasurer is hereby fixed at the

sum of \$1,000.00 per annum, effective May 1, 1948.

Section 3. The officer holding the merged or combined office of City Clerk and City Treasurer shall give surety bond for the faithful performance of his duties and for all funds to be handled by him in the amount of \$30,000.00, the premium on such bond to be paid by the City of Lexington. The amount of the bond, as provided herein, may be changed at any time by Resolution of the Mayor and Council.

Passed and approved this 24th day of February, 1948, and ordered published as by law provided.
