

ORDINANCE NO. 504.

An Ordinance to amend Section 4 of Article II of Chapter 2 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, which was passed and approved on April 7, 1943.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:


Section 1. That Section 4 of Article II of Chapter 2 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, which was passed and approved on April 7, 1943, shall be amended to read as follows:

"Section 4. OPENING AND CLOSING, HOURS OF. *- That it shall be unlawful for any person, persons or corporation within the corporate limits of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, being the owner of or conducting any pool or billiard hall therein, to keep open or allow or permit to be kept open such place of business between the hours of 11 o'clock P.M. and 6 o'clock A.M. on all week days, except Saturday, and between the hours of 12 o'clock midnight on Saturday and 6 o'clock A.M. on the following Monday; and it shall be unlawful for any person, persons or corporation within the limits of said city, being the owner of or conducting any bowling alley therein, to keep open or allow or permit to be kept open such place of business between the hours of 11:30 o'clock P.M. and 6 o'clock A.M. on all week days except Saturday, and between the hours of 12 o'clock midnight on Saturday and 12 o'clock noon on the following Sunday, and between the hours of 11 o'clock P. M. on Sunday and 6 o'clock A. M. on the following Monday; and it shall be unlawful for any person, persons or corporation to play or permit to be played, within any room in which shall be conducted any such pool or billiard hall or bowling alley, any musical instrument of any kind, excepting radio and other mechanical music box."

Section 2. That said Section 4 of Article II of Chapter 2 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, which was passed and approved on April 7, 1943, is hereby repealed.
