

ORDINANCE NO. 590

An Ordinance to amend Sections 3 and 5 of Article VIII of Chapter 2 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Ordinance No. 378, which was passed and approved by the Mayor and Council of said City on April 7, 1943.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. That Sections 3 and 5 of Article VIII of Chapter 2 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, Ordinance No. 378, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. License issued as herein provided shall not be assignable and the licensee shall be required to personally conduct or supervise the business carried on under said license.

Section 5. CANCELLATION OF LICENSES. HOURS CLOSED.
The Council of said City shall have the right, and may, with or without cause, cancel the license issued hereunder if any of the provisions of said Ordinance are violated by the licensee or when they find that the public good requires the cancellation thereof, or if, in the opinion of said Council, the licensee is not conducting said business in a proper manner or for the welfare of the inhabitants of said City. No person operating a skating rink in said City shall permit minors to enter said rink or to skate therein after being so notified by the parents or guardian of said minors, in writing. All skating rinks shall close and skating shall be prohibited between the hours of 11:30 o'clock P.M. and 7 o'clock A. M. on week days and between the hours of 11:30 o'clock P.M. on Saturday night and 12 o'clock noon on Sunday.

Section 2. That said original Sections 3 and 5 of Article VIII of Chapter 2 of the municipal Code of the City of Lexington be and the same are hereby repealed.
