

ORDINANCE NO. 663

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AND CREATE AND DIVIDE INTO FIVE WARDS THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, TO BE CALLED FIRST WARD, SECOND WARD, THIRD WARD, FOURTH WARD, AND FIFTH WARD RESPECTIVELY AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREOF, AND TO REPEAL ARTICLE 6, CHAPTER 4 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That the City of Lexington, Nebraska, is hereby divided into five wards to be called the First Ward, the Second Ward, the Third Ward, the Fourth Ward, and the Fifth Ward respectively, as follows:

THE FIRST WARD shall include all that part of said City lying north of the center line of the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way, east of the east line of Washington Street and south of 10th Street.

THE SECOND WARD shall include all that part of said City lying north of 10th Street and east of the east line of Washington Street, and said line extended.

THE THIRD WARD shall include all that part of said City lying north of 10th Street and west of the east line of Washington Street, and said line extended.

THE FOURTH WARD shall include all that part of said City lying north of the center line of the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way, west of the east line of Washington Street and south of 10th Street.

THE FIFTH WARD shall include all that part of said City lying south of the center line of the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way.


Section 2. That Article 6, Chapter 4, of the Municipal Code of Lexington and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict thereof, be and the same are hereby repealed.
