

ORDINANCE NO. 734

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A STREET LOCATED BETWEEN BLOCKS ELEVEN AND TWELVE AND LYING NORTH OF BLOCK TWO BETWEEN SAID BLOCK AND THE UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY ALL WITHIN C. L. ERVIN'S SUBDIVISION TO THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. That part of the street lying between Blocks Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) and described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Block Eleven (11); thence North Eighty (80) Feet to the Southeast corner of Block Twelve (12); thence West Three Hundred (300) Feet to the Southwest corner of Block Twelve (12); thence South Eighty (80) Feet to the Northwest corner of Block Eleven (11); thence East Three Hundred Feet (300) to the place of beginning:


And that portion of the street lying between Block Two (2) and the Union Pacific Railroad Right-of-Way, described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of Block Two (2); thence North Eighty (80) Feet, more or less, to the South boundary line of the Union Pacific Railroad Right-of-Way; thence in a Southeasterly direction along the South boundary line of the Union Pacific Railroad Right-of-Way to a point where the South boundary line of said Right-of-Way intersects with the North boundary line of said Block Two (2); thence in a Westerly direction along the North boundary line of Block Two (2) to the place of beginning:


all being located in C. L. Ervin's Subdivision to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, shall be and the same hereby are vacated.

Section 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
