ORDINANCE NO. 770

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 5-104 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 5 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, PROVIDING THE TIME FOR SALE OF LIQUOR AND BEER; PROHIBITING THE SALE OF THE SAME ON CERTAIN DAYS AND DURING CERTAIN TIMES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. That Section 5-104 of Article One (1) Chapter Five (5) of the Municipal code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, be amended to read as follows:

TIME LIMITS OF SALE. No person shall within said City sell at retail any alcoholic liquor, including beer, on the day of any national, state, county or municipal election, including primary election, during the hours the polls are open in said City. No person shall, within said city, sell at retail any alcoholic liquor, including beer, on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, Memorial Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas; when Memorial Day or Christmas fall on Sunday, the following day shall be considered as a holiday for the purposes of this section. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell alcoholic liquor, including beer, within said City, on secular days between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M.
