

ORDINANCE NO. 789

AN ORDINANCE CREATING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 27, AND PROVIDING FOR CURB, GUTTER, GRAVEL, GRADING AND DRAINAGE THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. That there is hereby created within the City an improvement district, to be known as "IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 27."


Section 2. That said Improvement District shall consist of that portion of West High Street from Washington Street to Madison Street, and the west side of Washington Street from High Street north for a distance of one hundred fifty feet.

Section 3. That there shall be constructed and provided on that portion of West High Street from Washington Street to Madison Street and that portion of the west side of Washington Street north from High Street for a distance of one hundred fifty feet, curb, gutter, gravel, grading and drainage as needed; that curb, gutter, gravel, grading, and drainage shall be in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates to be hereafter adopted.

Section 4. That the streets provided in the above section will abut on concrete paving already laid.

Section 5. That the cost of such curb, gutter, gravel, grading and drainage, except street and alley intersections, shall be assessed against the lots and tracts of land abutting said portions of streets, specifically benefited thereby, in proportion to the benefits received, to be determined by the City Council as provided by law.
