

RESOLUTION NO. 899

WHEREAS, Chapter 19, Article 10 of the Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943 (the Housing Authorities Law for Primary, First-Class, and Second-Class Cities, and Villages), provides for the establishment of a housing authority in cities of the first class by proper resolution, and

WHEREAS, the City of Lexington, Nebraska, desires to establish a housing authority under the provisions of said act for the purpose and uses therein set forth:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

THAT the City Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, hereby determines, finds and declares, in pursuance of the Housing Authorities Law for Primary, First-Class, and Second-Class Cities, and Villages;

1. The City of Lexington, Nebraska is a city having a population of more than one thousand and less than one hundred and fifty thousand inhabitants; and
2. Insanitary and unsafe inhabited dwelling accommodations exist in the city of Lexington, Nebraska; and
3. There is a shortage of safe and sanitary dwelling accommodations in the city of Lexington, Nebraska available to persons of low income at rentals they can afford; and
4. There is need for a Housing Authority to function in the city of Lexington, Nebraska; and
5. Such Housing Authority be and is hereby created.
