

ORDINANCE NO. 914

AN ORDINANCE CREATING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 73
AND PROVIDING FOR CONCRETE ^{RE} PAVING, GRADING AND DRAINAGE THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA,

SECTION 1. That there is hereby created within the City
an Improvement District to be known as IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 73.

SECTION 2. That said Improvement District shall consist
of the alley in Blocks Forty-five and Forty-six (Bk. 45 and 46), Original
Town of Plum Creek, now City of Lexington (the alley extending from
Grant Street to Lincoln Street and located between Fifth (5th) and
Sixth (6th) Streets).

SECTION 3. That there shall be constructed and provided on
the said alley in Blocks Forty-five and Forty-six (Bk. 45 and 46), Or-
iginal Town of Plum Creek, now City of Lexington, ^{RE} paving, drainage and
grading as needed; that the ^{RE} paving, drainage and grading shall be in
accordance with plans, specifications and estimates to be hereafter
adopted.

SECTION 4. That the alley provided in the above section
will abut on concrete paving already laid.

SECTION 5. That the cost of such ^{RE} paving, drainage and grading
shall be assessed against the lots and tracts of land abutting said alley,
specifically benefited thereby, in proportion to the benefits received to
be determined by the City Council as provided by law.
