

ORDINANCE NO. 1046

AN ORDINANCE vacating Van Buren Street from Washington Boulevard to Ash Street and to repeal all Ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:


Section 1. Whereas, all the owners of lots adjoining thereto have requested the vacation of Van Buren Street from Washington Boulevard to Ash Street and we deem it advantageous and best for the interest of the City to vacate such street, now, therefore,

Section 2. Van Buren Street from Washington Boulevard to Ash Street is hereby wholly and entirely vacated, and shall no longer be or constitute any part of the street system of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and the ownership thereof shall be retained in the name of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section. 3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict hereof shall be and the same hereby are repealed.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
