ORDINANCE NO. 1244

AN ORDINANCE VACATING ONTARIO STREET FROM VINE STREET NORTH TO THE UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY; AND VACATING THE ALLEY IN BLOCK "A" OF MACCOLL AND LEFLANG'S ADDITION IN THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, FROM 13th STREET SOUTH TO THE ATHLETIC FIELD OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 1.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:


Section 1. Ontario Street from Vine Street north to the Union Pacific Right-of-way is hereby wholly and entirely vacated and shall no longer be or constitute any part of the street system of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and the ownership thereof shall be retained in the name of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 2. The alley in Block "A", MacColl and Leflang's Addition in the City of Lexington, Nebraska, from 13th Street south to the athletic field of School District No. 1 is hereby wholly and entirely vacated, and shall no longer be or shall constitute any part of the alley system of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and the ownership thereof shall revert to the owner of the adjacent real estate one-half upon each side thereof, reserving to the City, however, an easement for all public utilities, to maintain, replace or repair such utilities, and prohibiting any construction of any building over or on such easement.

Section 3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be enforced from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
