ORDINANCE NO. 1308

AN ORDINANCE CREATING WATER CONNECTION DISTRICT
NO. 2, PROVIDING FOR A WATER MAIN THEREIN, AND REPEALING
ORDINANCE NO. 1306.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That there is hereby created within the
City, a Water Connection District, to be known as "Water Connection
District No. 2", consisting of property described as
follows, to-wit:

The lots and tracts of land abutting upon
and adjacent to Park Street from 13th Street
to 15th Street, in the City of Lexington,
Dawson County, Nebraska.


Section 2. That a six inch (6") cast iron water main
as ordered by the City Manager shall be laid in said district
running generally north to south down the middle of Park Street
in accordance with the plans, specifications, and estimates to be
hereinafter adopted.

Section 3. That said Water Connection District is
ordered pursuant to Section 16-6102, Reissue Revised Statutes,
of 1943, as amended; that the cost of said water main shall not
be levied as a special assessment against the property within
the district, but shall be paid out of a connection fee in the
amount of benefit accruing to the property in the district at
the time such property becomes connected to the water main.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 1306, passed and approved by
the Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington on May 8, 1973,
creating a Water Extension District for this same district shall
be and the same is hereby repealed.


Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
