

ORDINANCE NO. 1347

AN ORDINANCE CREATING WATER CONNECTION DISTRICT NO. 5,  
AND PROVIDING FOR A WATER MAIN THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. There is hereby created a Water Connection  
District, to be known as "Water Connection District No. 5",  
consisting of property described as follows, to-wit:


Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot  
Twelve (12), in Block One (1), Meads Addition  
to the City of Lexington, Dawson County,  
Nebraska; thence North along the West line of  
Lots One to Twelve (1 to 12) of Block One (1)  
to the Northwest corner of Lot One (1), Block  
One (1); thence West on the South line of  
Thirteenth Street to the Northwest corner of  
Lot Twenty-four (24), Block One (1); thence  
North on the East line of Garfield Street  
extended to the North a distance of Two Hundred  
Sixteen feet (216'); thence East on a line  
One Hundred Fifty feet North (150' N) of and  
parallel to the North line of Thirteenth Street  
to the West line of Taft Street; thence South  
on the West line of Taft Street to the North-  
east corner of Lot One (1), Block One (1); thence  
East on the South line of Thirteenth Street  
a distance of Two Hundred Sixteen feet (216');  
thence South on a line One Hundred Fifty feet  
East (150' E) of and parallel to the East line  
of Taft Street a distance of Nine Hundred Forty-  
two and seven-tenths feet (942.7'); thence West  
on the South line of Eleventh Street extended,  
a distance of Three Hundred Forty-one and four-  
tenths feet (341.4'); thence North Sixty feet  
(N 60') to the point of beginning.

Section 2. A six inch (6") cast iron water main as  
ordered by the City Manager shall be laid in said District in  
accordance with the plans, specifications and estimates to be  
hereinafter adopted.

Section 3. That said Water Connection District is  
ordered pursuant to Section 16-6102, Reissue, Revised Statutes,  
of 1943, as amended; that the cost of said water main shall not  
be levied as a special assessment against the property within the  
District, but shall be paid out of a connection fee in the amount  
of benefit accruing to the property in the District at the time such  
property becomes connected to the water main.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
