ORDINANCE NO. 1506

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AMENDING SECTION 24-1 AND REPEALING SECTION 24-1.1 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE, PROHIBITING THE OBSTRUCTION OF ANY STREET, ALLEY OR SIDEWALK AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION IN PHAMPLET FORM AND EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 24-1.1 of the Lexington City Code is hereby repealed and Section 24-1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. OBSTRUCTING STREETS PROHIBITED

No person shall erect, or cause to be erected, or shall leave or place, or permit to be left or placed, in any street or alley or on or in any sidewalk, any vehicle, wood, stone, metal, or any mailbox or any other object, article, or thing, whatsoever in such manner as to obstruct or interfere in any manner with the public use of the street, alley or sidewalk, except as provided in Section 24-2. However, property owners who have placed mailboxes on or in sidewalks prior to June 1, 1977, may, at their option, leave said mailboxes in or on the sidewalk, provided that the mailboxes were not negligently erected or are not negligently maintained and do not create a hazard or dangerous condition and provided further that the property owners sign an agreement with the City holding the City harmless and agreeing to indemnify the City for any personal or property damages suffered by any person or persons that the City becomes liable to pay as a result of the negligence in erection or maintainence of such mailbox by the property owner.


Section 2. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

Any person who shall violate, neglect or refuse to comply with Section 1 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable as provided in Section 1-7 of the Lexington City Code and shall be liable for all damages or injury suffered by any person who is injured by the failure or neglect of the owner and occupant of the real estate to comply with Section 1.
