ORDINANCE NO. 1522

AN ORDINANCE VACATING LOTS ELEVEN (11) AND TWELVE (12) OF BLOCK ELEVEN (11), J.L. MAYS ADDITION TO PLUM CREEK, NOW CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:


Section 1: Whereas, all the owners of lots and lands thereto have requested a vacation of Lots Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) of Block Eleven (11), J.L. Mays Addition to Plum Creek, now City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, and the City Council deems it advantageous and best for the interests of the City to vacate the same, now, therefore,

Section 2. Lots Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) of Block Eleven (11), J.L. Mays Addition to Plum Creek, now City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, are hereby wholly vacated, excepting, however, any and all public highways, streets, alleys, and public grounds heretofore dedicated to the public which shall be retained in the name of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 3. All of the sections or parts of sections in conflict herewith are repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
