

AN ORDINANCE CREATING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 229 PROVIDING FOR GRADING, CONCRETE PAVING AND DRAINAGE THEREIN; AND ORDERING THE ORDINANCE PUBLISHED IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. There is hereby created within the City of Lexington, Improvement District to be known as "Improvement District No. 229".

Section 2. The Improvement District shall consist of the following alley in the City of Lexington, Nebraska:

The alley between Sixth Street and Seventh Street, running from Washington Street to Grant Street, and the property abutting: The South Fifty Feet (S50') of Lot One (1) and East Ten Feet (E10') of South Fifty Feet (S50') of Lot Two (2); the West Forty Feet (W40') of Lot Two (2) and all of Lot Three (3); the East Half of Lot Four (4); the South Forty-nine and Eight Tenths Feet (49.8') of Lots Five (5) and Six (6) and the South Fifty Feet (S50') of the West Half of Lot Four (4); the North Forty-eight Feet (N48') of Lots Seven (7) and Eight (8); and all of Lots Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12).

Section 3. There shall be constructed and provided on the above described alley, grading, paving and drainage which shall be in accordance with the plans, specifications, and estimates to be hereinafter adopted.

Section 4. The alley provided in the above section will abut on curb and gutter where it exists.

Section 5. That the cost of such grading, paving and drainage shall be assessed against lots and tracts of land abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of the alley, specifically benefited thereby, in proportion to the benefit received, to be determined by the City Council as the law provides.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
