ORDINANCE NO. 1774

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 3-6; TO PROVIDE FOR SUNDAY OFF SALE OF BEER AND WINE AT RETAIL; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTION 3-6 AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 3-6 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 3-6. Hours of sale generally.

- (a) No alcoholic liquors shall be sold at retail or dispensed on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, or on Thanksgiving Day or Christmas, between the hours of 1:00 A.M. and 1:00 A.M. the day following, except that beer and wine may be sold at retail for off-premises consumption only on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, or on Thanksgiving Day or Christmas, between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 1:00 A.M. the day following.
- (b) No alcoholic liquors, including beer, shall be sold at retail or dispensed on secular days between 1:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M.
- (c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit licensed premises from being open for other business on days and hours during which the sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor is prohibited by this section.
- Section 2. The original Section 3-6 and all other ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
