ORDINANCE NO. 1804

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION OF SOUTH TAYLOR STREET BETWEEN IVAN STREET AND VINE STREET; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following portion of street within the City of Lexington, as previously platted and dedicated, is hereby vacated, with the right of way to revert to adjoining landowners, to-wit:

That portion of South Taylor Street between the South Right-of-Way Line of Ivan Street extended and the North Right-of-Way Line of Vine Street extended.

Section 2. That all previous ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
