ORDINANCE NO. 1822

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT USE OF SOLID FUELS THAT CONTAIN TOXIC OR HAZARDOUS WOOD PRESERVATIVES; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following shall be added as Section 18-5 to the Municipal Code.

Section 18-5. Toxic or Hazrdous Chemicals from Fireplaces or Stoves.

No fuels used in solid fuel heating appliances shall contain substances which are hazardous chemicals or cancer causing agents, such as wood preservatives of pentachlorophenol, creosote and arsenates. Substances which are hereby declared unlawful for burning shall include, but not be limited to such items as railroad ties, lightpoles and fenceposts containing wood preservatives.

Section 2. That all other ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
