ORDINANCE NO. 1892

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 16-49 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE; TO PROVIDE PARALLEL PARKING ON LINCOLN STREET ON THE SOUTH ONE-HALF OF THE BLOCK BETWEEN 5TH STREET AND 6TH STREET; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 16-49 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 16-49 Parallel and Angle Parking.

No persons shall stand or park a vehicle in a roadway, other than parallel with the edge of the roadway, headed in the direction of traffic, and with the curbside wheels of the vehicle within twelve inches of the edge of the roadway, except as provided in the following paragraphs:

- (a) Upon the following streets which have been marked on signs for angle parking, vehicles shall be parked at the angle to the curb indicated by such mark or signs:

Fifth Street, Lincoln Street to Grant Street
Fourth Street, Washington Street to Grant Street
Seventh Street, Lincoln Street to Grant Street
Sixth Street, Lincoln Street to Grant Street
Washington Street, Pacific Avenue to Seventh Street
Grant Street, West side, Fifth Street to Eighth Street
Lincoln Street, East side, alley north of Fifth Street to
Seventh Street

- (b) In places where and at hours when stopping for the loading or unloading of merchandise or materials is permitted, vehicles used for transportation of merchandise or materials may back into curb to take on or discharge loads.

Section 2. That original Section 16-49 of the Lexington City Code, together with all other ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
