ORDINANCE NO. 1901

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE PIONEER DRIVE, A CITY STREET LOCATED BETWEEN BLOCKS SIX (6) AND SEVEN (7) OF SOUTHAVEN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA; TO RETAIN OWNERSHIP OF SAID STREET; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, Pioneer Drive is a dedicated street located between Block 6 and Block 7 of Southaven Addition to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, and that said street has not been improved, opened or used for public travel, and should be vacated.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Pioneer Drive, as above described, is hereby vacated, with record title to said real estate to be retained by the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and shall remain attached to that part of Block 6, Southaven Addition to the City of Lexington, Nebraska, which is presently owned by the City of Lexington, Nebraska.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
