ORDINANCE NO. 1924

AN ORDINANCE CREATING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 91-1, PROVIDING STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENTS ON LINCOLN STREET, AND ORDERING THE ORDINANCE TO BE PUBLISHED IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. There is hereby created within the City of Lexington, an Improvement District to be known as "Improvement District No. 91-1."

Section 2. The Improvement District shall consist of the following area in the City of Lexington, Nebraska:

The West One-Half (W 1/2) of Blocks Thirty-Five (35) and Forty-Six (46), and the East One-Half (E 1/2) of Blocks Thirty-Four (34) and Forty-Seven (47), together with adjoining Lincoln Street right-of-way, in the Original Town of Plum Creek, now City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 3. There shall be constructed and provided on the above described streets, Storm Sewer Improvements which shall be in accordance with the plans, specifications, and estimates to be hereinafter adopted.

Section 4. That the cost of such Storm Sewer Improvements may be assessed against lots and tracts of land abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of the streets, specifically benefited thereby, in proportion to the benefit received, to be determined by the City Council as the law provides.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
