ORDINANCE NO. 1934

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE WATER EXTENSION DISTRICT NO. 91-5; TO PROVIDE THE BOUNDARIES OF SUCH DISTRICT, THE DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION OF WATER MAINS, AND THE OUTER BOUNDARIES OF SAID DISTRICT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That it is deemed necessary and advisable for the City of Lexington to construct water mains which extend into newly annexed areas of the City of Lexington, from existing water mains, and therefore Water Extension District No. 91-5 is hereby created.

2. That the improvements to be constructed within said district are twelve inch (12") ductile steel or PVC water mains, located as shown on the attached exhibit.

3. That plans and specifications for said water main project, heretofore filed with the office of the Lexington City Clerk, are hereby approved, and the City engineer's cost estimate of \$16,820.00 is hereby accepted.

4. That the boundaries of the Water Extension District No. 91-5 are as follows:

A tract of land located in the North Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 17, Township 9 North, Range 21 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, Dawson County, Nebraska, and more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point 50 feet North of the Southeast Corner of said North Half of the Southwest Quarter; thence North 250 feet; thence West 300 feet parallel to the South line of said North Half of the Southwest Quarter; thence South 250 feet parallel to

the East line of said North Half of the Southwest Quarter; thence East 300 feet, to the place of beginning; EXCEPTING THEREFROM a tract of land conveyed to The State of Nebraska, Department of Roads, by Warranty Deed recorded in Book 139, Page 483, and Quitclaim Deed recorded in Book 139, Page 486, all in the Deed Records of Dawson County, Nebraska;

5. That the cost of construction of such water extension district shall be assessed against property within the district, according to the extent of special benefit, and the City of Lexington shall adopt further rules and regulations governing the time and manner of connections to said water main extension.

6. That this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
