

ORDINANCE NO. 2228

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE SALE OF THE SOUTH 16.84 FEET OF LOT 3 AND ALL OF LOT 4, BLOCK 1, MacCOLL AND LEFLANG'S SECOND ADDITION TO THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA; TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION AND THE RIGHT OF REMONSTRANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That in consideration of fulfillment of the terms of a separate agreement for housing development, the following described real estate shall be transferred to the COUNCIL FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, to-wit:

The South 16.84 feet of Lot 3 and all of Lot 4, Block 1,
MacColl and Leflang's Second Addition to the City of
Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska;

Section 2. That immediately upon adoption, notice of this Ordinance shall be published in a legal newspaper for three (3) consecutive weeks; that if remonstrance against such sale signed by legal electors equal in number to thirty percent (30%) of the electors of the City voting at the last regular municipal election shall be filed with the Lexington City Clerk within thirty (30) days of such publication, such property shall not then, nor within one (1) year thereafter be sold.

(c) The speed limit shall be forty miles per hour on the following street or parts of street:

Bridge Street, Maple to 550' South of Sagebrush Lane

d) The speed limit shall be forty-five miles per hour on the following streets or parts of streets:

Pacific Avenue, East City Limits to 700 feet East of Monroe Street

Pacific Avenue, 600 feet West of Adams to West City Limits

Plum Creek Parkway, 550' South of Sagebrush Lane to South City Limits

(e) The speed limit shall be 15 miles per hour in the school zone on the following street or part of street, while flashing lights are in operation:

Walnut Street, Lincoln Street to Madison Street

West 13th Street, from the alley one-half block east of Harrison street to the alley one-half block west of Harrison Street

East 13th Street, from Tyler Street to Jefferson Street

West 10th Street from Taylor Street to one-half block east of Harrison Street

Section 2. That original Sec. 16-41, together with all ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 2227

AN ORDINANCE TO REZONE BLOCK 3 OF PRICE'S SECOND ADDITION TO THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, FROM A-1 AGRICULTURAL TO R-4 MOBILE HOME DISTRICT; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:


- Section 1. That the following described property, to-wit:
- Block 3, Price's Second Addition to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska,
- is hereby rezoned from A-1 Agricultural to R-4 Mobile Home District.

ORDINANCE NO. 2226

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2-2 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE; TO AMEND THE TIME OF REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTION 2-2 AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 2-2 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

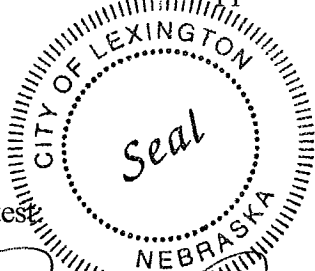
Sec. 2-2 Meeting of City Council.

Regular meetings of the City Council shall be held at the City offices at 5:30 P.M., on the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month. Special meetings shall be held as may be provided by the statutes of the State. The place and time of the meetings may be changed by the majority of the Council. A notice of such change of meetings shall be published in a legal newspaper at least one week before such meeting.

Section 2. That original Section 2-2, together with all ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect March 1, 2007.
