

ORDINANCE NO. 2439

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE THE OFFENSE OF FAILURE TO APPEAR; AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. SECTION 22-2 (Reserved) of the LEXINGTON CITY CODE IS HEREBY REPEALED AND REPLACED WITH THE FOLLOWING:

It shall be unlawful for any person who has been issued a traffic citation, criminal citation, or in any other manner set at liberty, with or without posting bail, upon the condition that he will subsequently appear in court at a specific time and place, purposely or knowingly fail or refuse to appear at that time and place to answer any charge(s) brought against him. It is unlawful for any person who has appeared in court in response to a traffic citation, criminal citation and/or booking bond to purposely or knowingly fail or refuse to appear in court at any other subsequent time and place set by the court to answer the charge(s).

Section 2. REPEAL

(a) That all ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. PAMPHLET FORM

(a) That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
