

RESOLUTION.

A Resolution requesting the County Treasurer of Dawson County, Nebraska, to combine into one account all Water Bond Accounts of the City of Lexington in the office of the Treasurer.

Whereas, the City of Lexington has outstanding the following issues of Water Bonds:

Water Refunding Issue, dated June 1, 1939, on which there is a balance of bonds outstanding in the amount of \$13,000.00.

Water Bonds, dated July 1, 1947, on which there is a balance of bonds outstanding in the amount of \$15,000.00.

Water Bonds, dated November 1, 1947, on which there is a balance of bonds outstanding in the amount of \$65,000.00.

Whereas, it will simplify the making of city levies and the payment of such bonds, if all funds received by the County Treasurer, from the levy for Water Bonds and Water Refunding Bonds, are carried in one Water Bond Fund for the account of said City of Lexington.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

1. That the County Treasurer of Dawson County, Nebraska, is hereby requested to combine into one Water Bond Fund, all of the Water Bond accounts now carried on the books of the County Treasurer, for the payment of principal and interest on the following issues of Water Bonds, issued by the City of Lexington, to-wit:

(a) Water Refunding Bonds, Issue of \$31,000, dated June 1, 1939; Balance outstanding, \$13,000.

(b) Water Bonds, Issue of \$15,000, dated July 1, 1947; Balance outstanding, \$15,000.

(c) Water Bonds, Issue of \$65,000, dated November 1, 1947; Balance outstanding, \$65,000.

2. That one levy shall be hereafter made for the payment of the principal of said bonds, together with the accrued interest thereon.


3. That the City Clerk shall execute and deliver to the County Treasurer of Dawson County, Nebraska, a true and certified copy of this Resolution.
