

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS many citizens of the City of Lexington have requested that minimum standards of construction and quality of materials be adopted for the regulation of the building industry in the City of Lexington and,

WHEREAS the City Council and the Planning Commission of the City have studied the matter and decreed that such regulation is feasible and desirable and in the public interest and have devised rules and regulations to accomplish such regulation and,

WHEREAS all proposed rules and regulations have been thoroughly explained and discussed by representatives of the building trades to which said rules and regulations apply in scheduled public hearing,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the President of the Council and the Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, that

1. Pursuant to the provisions of City Ordinance No. 748 the following rules and regulations shall be in full force and effect: Building Code, Structural Section; Building Code, Gas Fired Appliance Section; Building Code, Plumbing Section; Building Code, Electrical Section, copies of which are hereby attached and made a part thereto.
2. That upon and after the date Ordinance No. 748 becomes effective the City Manager is directed to enforce all requirements of Building Code sections listed above.
3. That adequate copies of the Building Code sections listed above shall be prepared and issued, free of charge, to all persons requesting same.
4. That this resolution shall be made a part of the consolidated Building Code.
