

R E S O L U T I O N

Whereas, the activation of Ordinance No. 563, pertaining to the inspection and licensing of food and drink establishments, has been delayed since its passage and effective date of February 9, 1951, for the reason that it has been impossible to secure continuity in the employment of a sanitation, or Health Officer and,


Whereas, a City Sanitarian has now been inspecting such establishments for more than one year and most such establishments are now in reasonable compliance with the requirements of the ordinance,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the President of the Council and the City Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, that the operators of food and drink establishments have been adequately advised of the existence of the ordinance, that the time for full enforcement of the same is now, and that the following dates for applying for permit, final inspection of the establishment and the issuing of a permit if same is approved, are hereby fixed and that after said dates the operators of food and drink establishments not complying with the requirements of the ordinance will be deemed guilty of violation of the ordinance.

LAST DATE FOR PAYMENT OF FEE AND MAKING APPLICATION
FOR A PERMIT.....JUNE 30, 1955.

LAST DATE FOR SECURING APPROVAL OF SANITARIAN OR
HEALTH OFFICER.....July 30, 1955
