

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, there has been signed by the City of Lexington, on the 5th day of March, 1953, and by the State on the 11th day of March, 1953, an agreement providing for the construction of a Federal Aid Secondary Road beginning at the intersection of Walnut Street and Washington Street.

WHEREAS, in the above agreement, the City has pledged sufficient funds to finance it's share of the cost of the construction of this project identified as No. U-252(4), and

WHEREAS, the above mentioned agreement provided that the City would pay all of the non-Federal costs of this project, and


WHEREAS, the State received bids for the construction of this project on October 20, 1953, at which time six (6) bids were received for the construction of the proposed work, and

WHEREAS, the following contractor for the items of work listed has been selected as the low bidder to whom a contract should be awarded: MISSOURI VALLEY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY of Omaha, Nebraska, for Grading, Sand Gravel for Surfacing, Concrete Pavement and Culverts.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the above facts, the Council of the City of Lexington, by this resolution, takes the following official action:

1. The Council hereby concurs in the selection of the above mentioned contractor for the items of work listed, to whom a contract should be awarded.
2. The Council does not desire to perform any of the work with it's own forces in lieu of performing the work by the contractor mentioned.
