

RESOLUTION


WHEREAS the Council of the City of Lexington is acutely aware of its responsibility to the taxpayers who support the institutions of this Municipality and

WHEREAS any deficit resulting from the failure of the Hospital to support its operation from revenues must become a general obligation of all the taxpayers in the City of Lexington and


WHEREAS the drug and medical supplies together with food supplies and services needed in the operation of the Hospital represent a substantial portion of the gross expense of the hospital

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Lexington that the City Manager and the Hospital Manager be hereby directed to secure the above mentioned supplies and services for the Hospital at the lowest possible price consistent with maintenance of quality and that, all things being equal, preference be given local suppliers over equal periods of time.
