

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, 15th Street between Block Four (4) and Block Five (5) of Abel's First Addition of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, was duly vacated on August 11, 1953, by Ordinance Number 675, and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire to sell to each abutting property owner One-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the said vacated street for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:


That deeds be prepared conveying the South One-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the vacated street to James H. Byrns and Verna M. Byrns, husband and wife as Joint Tenants, with right of survivor and not as tenants in common and the North One-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the said vacated street be conveyed to Harry H. Foreman.

That the consideration for the said deed shall be One Dollar (\$1.00) for each deed.
