

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION ADOPTING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF TRAILER CAMPS PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NUMBER 625.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

That the following rules and regulations be and the same are hereby adopted pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance Number 625, of the said City of Lexington:

1. No trailer shall be parked closer than Ten (10) feet from any building, structure or other trailer used for human habitation, and all trailers must observe all zoning set back requirements.
2. No materials, articles, appliances or other articles may be stored or placed under or in front of the trailer.
3. Electric service, if any, including meter and fused safety switch must be provided separately for each trailer where municipal service is used.
4. Toilets, water closets, shower or bath tubs may not be used unless any and all such fixtures are connected to public water and sanitary systems.
5. Kitchen sinks, wash basins or lavatories may not be used unless connected with public sanitary system or connected with an approved container of suitable capacity to catch all waste matter therefrom. Contents of this container may not be allowed to overflow but must be disposed of by dumping into public sanitary system or other approved means.
6. Premises must be kept free and clear of debris, materials, appliances, garbage, trash or other unsightly or unsanitary accumulations.
7. Access to the premises must be permitted for the purpose of inspection by the City's Health Officer and Fire Protection Officer.
