

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, created Improvement District No. 51 of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, by Ordinance No. 865 duly passed on March 14, 1961, which ordinance was duly published according to law and the notice of the creation of the improvement district was further duly published according to law, and

WHEREAS, certain property owners objected to the creation of said improvement district by a remonstrance filed March 31, 1961, and

WHEREAS, two of said objectors requested that their names be withdrawn from such objection by petition duly filed April 12, 1961, and


WHEREAS, the recorded objectors to said improvement district constitute less than fifty per cent (50%) of the front footage of the property abutting or adjoining said improvement district, and

WHEREAS, the last day for filing objections to said improvement district was the 12th day of April, 1961,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS DULY RESOLVED THAT:


1. Improvement District No. 51 created by Ordinance No. 865 of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, be and is in full force and effect.
2. That since objections according to law have not been filed in the time and manner as provided in Section 16-620 R.R.S. Nebraska 1954, that the President of the Council and the City Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, shall forthwith proceed to construct such paving in said street.
