

RESOLUTION NO. 1495

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. BE IT RESOLVED, that the re-plat of the West One-half (W $\frac{1}{2}$ ) and the East One-half (E $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Block Sixteen (16), MacColl's Addition to Plum Creek, now Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, an addition to the City of Lexington, in the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, duly made out, acknowledged and certified be and the same hereby is approved, accepted and ordered filed and recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Dawson County, Nebraska, and hereafter the addition shall be and remain a part of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and shall be included within the corporate limits of the City and be and become a part of the City for all purposes whatsoever and the inhabitants of the Subdivision shall be entitled to all the rights and privileges and be subject to all Laws, Ordinances, Rules and Regulations of the City.
