

RESOLUTION NO. 1529

Whereas, the Watershed Work Plan Agreement for the Spring Creek Watershed, State of Nebraska, executed by the City of Lexington and the County of Dawson, hereinafter referred to as the Sponsoring Local Organization and the Soil Conservation Service of the United States Department of Agriculture, hereinafter referred to as the Service, became effective on the 25th day of January 1966; and

Whereas, a Supplemental Watershed Work Plan Agreement for Spring Creek Watershed, State of Nebraska, executed by the Sponsoring Local Organization named therein and the Service, became effective on the 1st day of October, 1971; and

Whereas, a Supplemental Watershed Work Plan which modifies the Watershed Work Plan dated August 1965 for said watershed has been developed through the cooperative efforts of the Sponsoring Local Organization and the Service, which plan is annexed to and made a part of this agreement; and

Now, therefore, the Sponsoring Local Organization and the Service hereby agree upon the following modifications of the terms, conditions, and stipulations of said Watershed Work Plan Agreement:

- 1: The City of Lexington and the County of Dawson does herewith assume all the rights, duties, responsibilities, and obligations of the Custer County and Dawson County Soil and Water Conservation Districts and the County of Custer as set forth in said plan.
2. The names of City of Lexington and County of Dawson will hereafter be substituted in lieu of the Custer County and Dawson County Soil and Water Conservation Districts.
3. Floodwater retarding structures 19-A, 20-A, 21-A, 22-A, 23-A, and 28-A referred to in the Watershed Work Plan are hereby deleted from the Work Plan and replaced with floodwater retarding structure 19-B.
4. The 1.77 miles of dike and 33.7 miles of channel improvement referred to in the Watershed Work Plan are hereby deleted from the Work Plan.
5. Paragraph numbered 1 is modified to read as follows:

The Sponsoring Local Organizations will acquire without cost to the Federal Government such land, easements, or rights-of-way as will be needed in connection with works of improvement. (Estimated cost - \$295,700.)

6. Paragraph numbered 3 is modified to read as follows:

The percentages of construction costs of structural measures to be paid by the Sponsoring Local Organizations and by the Service are as follows:

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7. Paragraph numbered 4 is modified to read as follows:

The percentages of the cost for installation services to be borne by the Sponsoring Local Organizations and the Service are as follows:



8. Paragraph numbered 5 is modified to read as follows:

The Sponsoring Local Organizations will bear the costs of administering contracts. (Estimated cost \$23,700.)

The Sponsoring Local Organization and the Service further agree to all other terms, conditions, and stipulations of said Watershed Work Plan as supplemented not modified herein.


