

RESOLUTION NO. 1531

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA,
CREATING A JOINT AIRPORT ZONING BOARD.

WHEREAS, the City of Lexington is presently the owner of the Lexington Airport, and

WHEREAS, the area of land extending out in all directions a distance fo three miles from the adjacent boundaries of said airport constitute an airport hazard area within the meaning of chapter three article three, Revised Statutes of Nebraska (re issue 1974), and

WHEREAS, the airport hazard area, appertaining to the above mentioned airport, is located partially within the County of Dawson and partially within the corporate limits of the City of Lexington, and partially within the area that is controlled by the zoning regulations of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and


WHEREAS, it is necessary and expedient that the City of Lexington, the political subdivision owning the above named airport, and the County of Dawson, the political subdivision within which a part of the airport hazard area is located, create a joint airport zoning board in accordance with chapter three article three Revised Statutes of Nebraska (re issue 1974).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Lexington that the City does hereby participate with the County of Dawson in the creation of a joint airport zoning board, to be known as the Lexington Joint Airport Zoning Board, and to that end there is hereby created the Lexington Joint Airport Zoning Board, which board shall have and exercise all the powers conferred, and perform all the duties enjoined upon it by the Airport Zoning Act.

Wayne Hodges and Ralph Coon, residents of the City of Lexington, are hereby appointed as members of the Lexington Joint Airport Zoning Board, to represent the City thereon.
