R E S O L U T I O N
REGARDING SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, that:


1. Sidewalks shall be constructed on property abutting the street improvements as now exist or as later may be constructed, within one(1) year after such improvements have been made, except for improvements bordering land used for agricultural purposes, as may be determined by the City Manager.

2. Property owners shall be given notice by the City Engineer to construct such sidewalks within Ninety (90) days of the notice or such property will be included in a sidewalk improvement district as provided by Statute.

3. Property along such improvements which may be used for agricultural purposes but which leaves a gap of Four Hundred Feet (400') or less between existing sidewalks or sidewalks to be constructed shall not be considered in the exception stated in paragraph one (1) above.


4. That upon the failure of property owners to construct sidewalks under the provisions of this Resolution, a sidewalk district shall be enacted for the construction of such sidewalks, as by law provided.
