
Whereas, the Overpass and/or Viaduct in the City of Lexington, Highway 283 and junction street will be completed very shortly and,

Whereas, some plan for regulating or directing said traffic must soon be adopted and,


Whereas, the City of Lexington finds itself lacking in facilities to make surveys leading to such a plan,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, that the City Manager be directed to request the assistance of the Department of Roads in conducting a survey and recommending a solution for the above problem, and that the City Manager present the results of the survey and the recommendations to the Planning Commission at the earliest possible date.
