

RESOLUTION NO. R1626

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON,  
NEBRASKA:

1. The Mayor and Council find and determine: That Street Improvement District No. 223 (Highway 30 Improvement Project) was duly created and a contract was let to Paulsen Building and Supply, Inc. of Cozad, Nebraska, for the construction of street improvements therein; that the City has been billed for a portion of the project and said bill is now due and owing to the State of Nebraska Department of Roads, and that said billing for street improvements in Street Improvement District No. 223 is hereby accepted and approved by the City and claims therefor are hereby allowed as follows:

State of Nebraska Department of Roads      \$303,307.70

2. Warrant No. 52 in the amount of \$303,307.70 shall be issued and delivered to the State of Nebraska Department of Roads. Said Warrant shall bear interest at the rate of 6% per annum for a period of six (6) months from date, and thereafter at the rate of 6½% per annum until paid, and show that it was issued for material furnished and work performed in the construction of improvements in said District and that it will be paid out of the proceeds of the sale of bonds.
