

RESOLUTION NO. R1627

WHEREAS, certain easements have been procured by the City of Lexington, Nebraska for the purpose of construction and maintenance of Sanitary Sewer District No. 90; and,

WHEREAS, said Sanitary Sewer District No. 90 has been dissolved by Ordinance No. 1629, passed March 13, 1979, and said easements should be released and abandoned;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the following described easements are hereby released and abandoned by the City of Lexington, Nebraska:

1. Easement dated August 14, 1978, and recorded at 53 Miscellaneous Records, page 339, over and across the East 6' of the West 20' of the South 23' of the North 47.5' of Lot 15, Block 36, Original Town of Plum Creek, now City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska;
2. Easement dated August 15, 1978, and recorded at 53 Miscellaneous Records, page 292, over and across the East 6' of the West 20' of the North 24.5' of Lot 5, Block 36, Original Town of Plum Creek, now City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska;
3. Easement dated August 16, 1978, and recorded at 53 Miscellaneous Records, page 290, over and across the South 5.2' of the North 47.5' of the East 30' of Lot 5, Block 36, Original Town of Plum Creek, now City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska;
4. Easement dated September 28, 1978, recorded at 53 Miscellaneous Records, page 228, over and across the East 8' of the West 14' of the South 50' of Lot 4, Block 36, Original Town of Plum Creek, now City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska;
5. Easement dated September 27, 1978, recorded at 53 Miscellaneous Records, page 286, over and across a part of the South one-half of the West one-half of the North Ninety (90) feet of Lot 4, Block 36, Original Town of Plum Creek, now City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City manager shall cause this Resolution to be recorded and made a part of the permanent records affecting the above described real estate.
