

WHEREAS, any changes to the Constitution of the Lexington Volunteer Fire Department are required to be confirmed by the City Council; and,


WHEREAS, the Lexington Volunteer Fire Department has at two (2) meetings approved a constitutional change, and such change is satisfactory.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the mayor and council of the city of Lexington, Nebraska, that the following change to the Constitution of the Lexington Volunteer Fire Department is hereby confirmed:

Article IX

Section III (New Section). Each member shall be considered to be on-call for active duty at all times. Active duty shall include (1) any regular or official activity of the department; (2) any activity relating to an alarm of fire or rescue, including travel to the fire station or to the place of fire or rescue after having received notice of an alarm; (3) any activity by a member in response to a fire or rescue, but not in response to an alarm, which is (a) within the geographic area served by the department, (b) when such fire or rescue could reasonably be expected by such member to be the basis for an alarm and response by the department, and (c) when under the circumstances then existing it appears to the member that it is not reasonably practicable to cause an alarm to be sounded prior to rendering assistance; or (4) any other activity which a member is required by law to perform.
