

RESOLUTION NO. R1637

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON,
NEBRASKA:


1. The Mayor and Council find and determine: That Street Improvement Districts No. 226, 227, and 228 were duly created and contracts were let to Paulson Building and Supply, Inc. of Cozad, Nebraska, for the construction of street improvements therein; that the construction has been completed and the City has been billed for the project, and said bill is now due and owing to Paulson Building and Supply, Inc.; that said billing for street improvements in Street Improvement Districts No. 226, 227, and 228 are hereby accepted and approved by the City and claims therefore are hereby allowed as follows:

To Paulson Building and Supply, Inc., contractor

Street Improvement District No. 226	\$11,742.60
Street Improvement District No. 227	\$13,995.67
Street Improvement District No. 228	<u>\$17,191.11</u>
Total	\$42,929.38

2. Warrant No. 1 thru 4 in the amount of \$42,929.38 shall be issued and delivered to Paulson Building and Supply, Inc. Said Warrant shall bear interest at the rate of seven per cent (7%) per annum until January 1, 1980, and thereafter at the rate of seven and one half per cent (7½%) per annum until paid, and show that it was issued for material furnished and work performed in the construction of improvements in said Districts and that it will be paid out of the proceeds of sale of bonds.
